

RoHS REACH CE Regulation Compliance Statement

RoHS Recast Directive 2011/65/EU

Products covered: All products supplied by Connexion Developments Ltd are RoHS and WEEE compliant unless the product is specifically stated otherwise. This is a general statement – please contact Connexion Developments Ltd if you require a product specific (by part number) declaration.

RoHS stands for Restriction Of Hazardous Substances, originally EU2002 RoHS Directive 2002/95/ restricts the use of six hazardous materials found in electrical and electronic products. Directive 2011/65/EU published in 2011 as RoHS-Recast or RoHS 2 includes a CE-marking directive, with RoHS compliance now being required for CE marking of products. RoHS 2 also added Categories 8 and 9. Directive 2015/863 is known as RoHS 3. RoHS 3 adds four additional restricted substances (phthalates) to the list of six.

Cadmium (Cd): < 0.01%, Lead (Pb): < 0.1%, Mercury (Hg): < 0.1%, Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI): < 0.1%, Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): < 0.1%, Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < 0.1%, Bis (2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): < 0.1%, Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): < 0.1%, Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): < 0.1%, Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): < 0.1%. <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/rohs-compliance-and-guidance>



WEEE Regulation Directive 2012/95/EC.

Recycling of WEEE is a specialist part of the waste and recycling industry. It is a rapidly growing sub-sector due largely to the implementation of the original WEEE Directive in the UK by the WEEE Regulations 2006, With that came the associated requirements for the recovery, reuse, recycling and treatment of WEEE. The Waste Electric and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations 2013 ("the Regulations") became law in the UK on the 1st of January 2014 and replaced the 2006 Regulations. The new Regulations transpose the main provisions of Directive 2012/19/EU on WEEE which recasts the previous Directive 2002/96/EC. These regulations also provide for a wider range of products to be covered by the Directive with effect from 1st January 2019. Connexion Developments Ltd is aware that under the WEEE directive as a supplier of any product that falls within the definition in the WEEE directive has several responsibilities with respect to product design, collection, treatment, and recovery.



REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006

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REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of CHemicals, REACH regulation EC 1907/2006). The member states committee (MSC) of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) has decided to include lead in the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidate list. As of 25th June 2020 there are 235 substances are now included on the SVHC Candidate List.

Connexion Developments Ltd certifies that to the best of its knowledge all products supplied do not contain substances listed on the Candidate List of substances of Very High Concern, as updated on 25th June 2020, in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight. CE Compliance.

CE compliance EU safety, health, and environmental requirements.

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CE marking is mandatory for any product traded within the single market European Economic Area (EEA) showing that the manufacturer or importer (if outside of EU) has checked the products meet EU safety, health and environmental requirements and is an indication of the products compliance with EU legislation for the free movement of products within the EEA. UK CA UKCA Compliance

UKCA compliance UK safety, health, and environmental requirements

The government has laid legislation to continue recognition of current EU requirements, including the CE marking (Conformité Européene, or European Conformity marking). The legislation will apply indefinitely for a range of product regulations. This means businesses will have the flexibility to use either the UKCA (UK Conformity Assessed) or CE marking to sell products in Great Britain (GB).
